

Official Minutes Regular Business Meeting October 29, 2019

The Central County Fire & Rescue Board of Directors held its Regular Monthly Business meeting on Tuesday, October 29, 2019, 6:00 p.m., at Headquarters located at 1220 Cave Springs Blvd., St. Peters, MO 63376. Assistant Chief Brown also presented to the Board a thank you letter from REHAB 95 members expressing their appreciation to Central County Board of Directors, administration staff, line personnel, committees and IAFF Local 2665 members for the acquisition of their new response vehicle.

Training: Chief Aubuchon stated that training on live burns was taking place this month.

<u>ALS</u>: Chief Medical Officer Sean Webb gave an ALS update. He stated that flu shots were almost completed and that the medical equipment maintenance has been completed.

This includes all license and subscriptions of 44 CCFR users for a total cost of \$2,385.00.
